Washington Gas representatives will discuss with interested residents the current work on Magarity Road, Peabody Drive and Lisle Avenue. Additionally, alternatives for the completion of the final phase of the project will be presented.

The open house format will allow residents to attend at their convenience anytime between 7:00 p.m. and 8:30 p.m.

CURRENT PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS:

Washington Gas is working with the Virginia Department of Transportation and Fairfax County on the final phase routing that will connect the regulator station under construction at the Pimmit Hills Center at 7510 Lisle Avenue with the existing Pimmit Hills Regulator Station off of Route 7 near Pimmit Drive.

Potential routes for completion of final phase:

- Fisher / Cherri Route (includes the following streets: Peabody Drive, Fisher Drive, Cherri Drive, Leonard Road, Cherri Drive, Griffith Road, Pimmit Drive)
- Magarity / Route 7 (Leesburg Pike) Route
